Eminent Prior welcomed the large number present out of 17 Charter members. Eleven members and two visitors were recorded present.

The Personal Representative of Most Eminent Grand Master General Vernon R. Parks, Most Eminent Albert S. Carney, was present and installed all of the officers. He then presented Em. Prior Law with the Warrant for Jesse Green Priory No. 70.

Em. Prior Law discussed the proposed by-laws which complied with the recommended uniform by-laws of the Convent General. Unanimous approval was granted to act upon them at this meeting. A motion was made, seconded, and passed that the by-laws be adopted. Copies were distributed to each member, and two copies are to be sent to the Registrar General for action. The fee for new invitees will be \$100.00.

All Delaware members of Philadelphia Priory No. 12 were contacted and consented to join Jesse Green Priory, but remain dual members in Philadelphia Priory. P.P. Warren Gray, Registrar of Philadelphia Priory, asked about status of Knight Samuel A. Wise. The answer was that since he resided in Pennsylvania he would remain a member of Philadelphia Priory.

Knight Coffin spoke about Jesse Green history, Knight Thomas about appreciation to Hank Law for his efforts, and Knight Blackwell about furnishing Grand Lodge with officer list.

A motion was made, seconded, and passed that Honorary Memberships be granted to Knights Vernon R. Parks, Albert S. Carney, Stanley W. Wakefield, Warren R. Gray, and John Harris Watts.

Most Eminent Carney reported that there were four smaller Priorities in existence.

Em. Prior Law stated that there would be a business meeting in January and a conferring ceremony in February with Most Eminent Vernon R. Parks to attend to formally consecrate the Priory.

There being no further business, the Priory was closed at 4:50 P.M.
