The Minutes of the Business Meeting held on September 8, 1988, were read and approved. The Treasurer's Report showed a current bank balance of \$301.40.

The acting Registrar reported that a request for a Waiver of Jurisdiction on S.K. Eugene D. Racz, a resident of Delaware, who had presided over the York Rite Bodies in Denton, Maryland, had been received from Francis Scott Key Priory No. 14. Upon ballot of the Knights present, the Waiver was unanimously granted.

The acting Registrar announced the passing of Knight J. Norman Nicklas on October 6, 1988. PP Law delivered a brief eulogy, following which a prayer was offered by Prelate Wagner.

The Eminent Prior met with Knights Horace G. Patterson, Jr., and Richard A. Scarlott at the Altar and presented each with a Certificate attesting that each had earned the honor of Knight York Grand Cross of Honour with One Quadrant, the first non-dual members of this Priory to have done so.

S.K. Richard E. Wise, having accepted the invitation and his fee having been paid, was announced in waiting and was admitted and received into membership in Jesse Green Priory No. 70. The Ceremony of Reception was conferred by Em. Prior Felmev assisted by the other Officers, with the Lectures being given by Donald D. Thomas, KYGCH - LODGE; Richard A. Scarlott, KYGCH - CHAPTER; T. Eugene Womach - COUNCIL; and Harry M. Sullivan, Jr., KYGCH - COMMANDERY. The Members Jewel was presented by Eminent Prior Felmev.


