In reviewing the activities of the Evening of Masonic Enlightenment, it was noted that as a result of the associated book sale, the Priory had realized a profit of about \$ 470.00. Upon motion by the Registrar, duly seconded, it was agreed to donate \$100.00 to Convent General Medical Research Foundation. It was also agreed to take an additional \$250.00, if needed, to purchase sufficient copies of Brother John Robinson's "A Pilgrim's Path" so that a copy of the book could be placed in each Community Library wherein there was a Constituted Lodge of this Grand Lodge. The presentation of same to be made at the Annual Communication of Grand Lodge. Further particulars to be handled by the Prior, Registrar and Knight James A. Pletz.
